Paper Dolls Quilt

Technique:	Piecing and Patchwork

The delightful 'paper doll' blocks in this quilt are made using a square (Template J), 5 rectangles (Templates H, K, L, O and P), a triangle (Template N) and a lozenge (Template M). The blocks finish to 8½ inches (21.5cm) square and are set in straight rows. The rows are offset by a half block and the ends of alternate rows are filled with a large rectangle (cut to size). The quilt is finished with a simple border with corner posts.

Size

The finished quilt will measure approx. 50½ x 59 inches (128.25cm x 150cm).

58in x 67in (147.25cm x 170.25cm)

Templates

See pages 4, 5, and 6.

Cutting

1. Cut the patch shapes in the order specified, always keeping remaining fabric in the largest size possible.
2. Template M Cut 4" (10.25cm) strips across the width of the fabric. Cut 5 in BM15PK, BM15SK, BM32BL, BM32MG, 4 in BM34YE and 3 in BM34BL. Total 27 patches.
3. Template K Cut 7½" x 2" (19cm x 5cm) rectangles. Cut 5 in BM15PK, BM15SK, BM32BL, BM32MG, 4 in BM34YE and 3 in BM34BL. Total 27 rectangles.
4. Large Rectangle Cut 9" x 4¾" (22.75cm x 12cm) rectangles. Cut 3 in BM36GN and BM36PK. Total 6 rectangles.
5. Template N Cut 4 3/8" (11cm) squares, then cut each square diagonally to form 2 triangles using the template as a guide. Handle the triangles carefully as the long edge will be on the bias and stretchy. Cut 10 in BM36GN, BM36PK, GP70LV, 8 in GP70PO, GP71LF and GP71PU. Total 54 triangles.
6. Template O Cut 4" x 2½" (10.25cm x 6.25cm) rectangles. Cut 10 in BM36GN, BM36PK, GP70LV, 8 in GP70PO, GP71LF and GP71PU. Total 54 rectangles.
7. Template H Cut 4" x 2" (10.25cm x 5cm) rectangles. Cut 10 in BM36GN, BM36PK, GP70LV, 8 in GP70PO, GP71LF and GP71PU. Total 54 rectangles.
8. Template J Cut 2" x 2" (5cm x 5cm) squares. Cut 7 in BM31BR, BM31OR, BM31YE and 6 in BM31GN. Total 27 squares.
9. Template L Cut 2" x 1¼" (5cm x 3.25cm) rectangles. Cut 14 in BM31BR, BM31OR, BM31YE and 12 in BM31GN. Total 54 rectangles.

10. Border Corner Posts: Cut $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (11.5cm x 11.5cm) squares. Cut 4 in BM37RD.
11. Template P Cut $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" (6.25cm x 5cm) rectangles. Cut 8 in BM37AU, 7 in BM37PT, BM37RD and 5 in BM37BE. Total 27 rectangles.
12. Border: Down the length of the fabric cut 2 borders $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $51\frac{1}{2}$ " (11.5cm x 130.75cm) for the quilt sides and 2 borders $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43" (11.5cm x 109.25cm) for the quilt top and bottom.
13. Binding: Cut 6 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.5cm) wide across the width of the fabric in SC35.
14. Backing: Cut 1 piece 40" x 67" (101.5 x 170.25cm), 1 piece 40" x 19" (101.5cm x 48.25cm) and 1 piece 28" x 19" (71cm x 48.25cm) in backing fabric.

Instructions

Seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ " (.64cm) unless otherwise noted.

Making the blocks

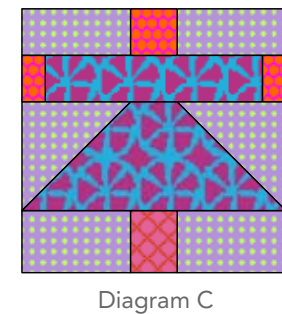
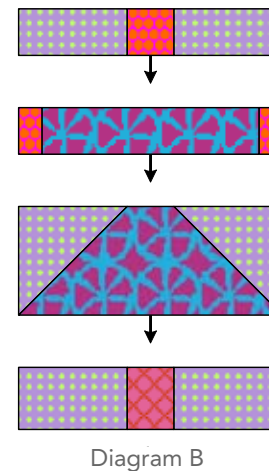
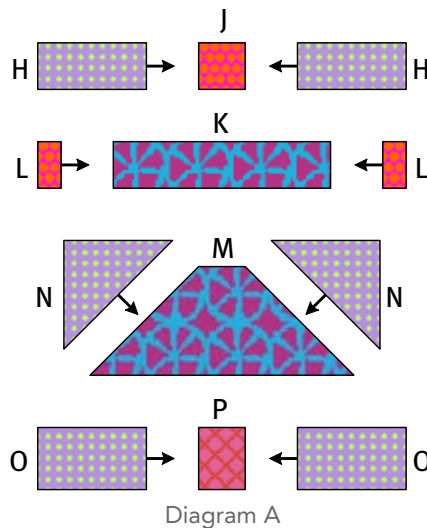
Refer to the quilt assembly diagram on page 6 for fabric placement. Lay out each set of patches as shown in block assembly Diagram A and join the patches into 4 rows. Join the 4 rows as shown in Diagram B to complete the block which can be seen in Diagram C. Make 27 blocks.

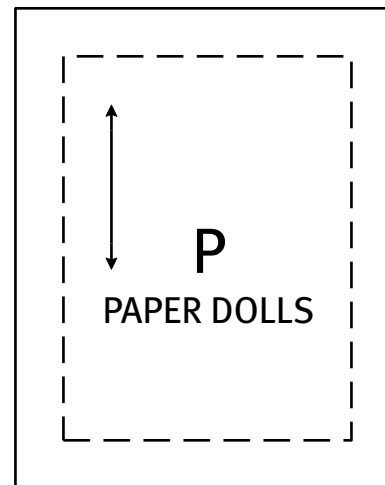
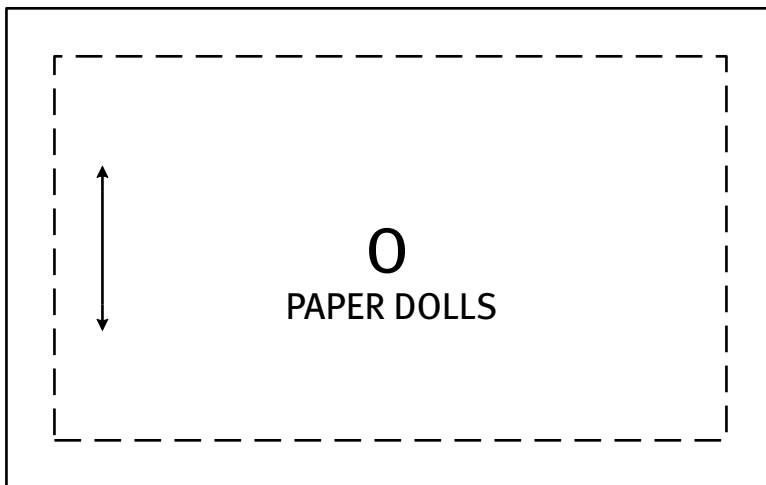
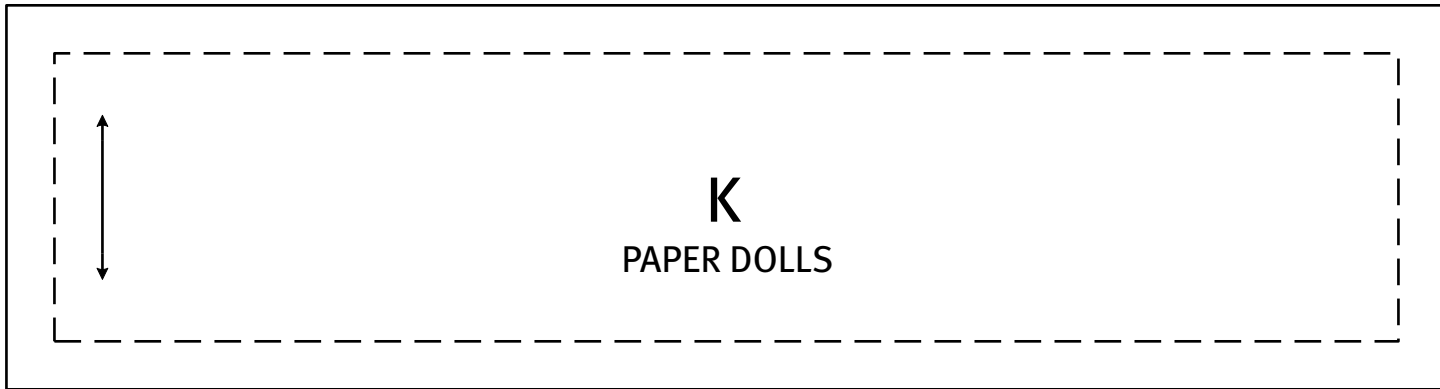
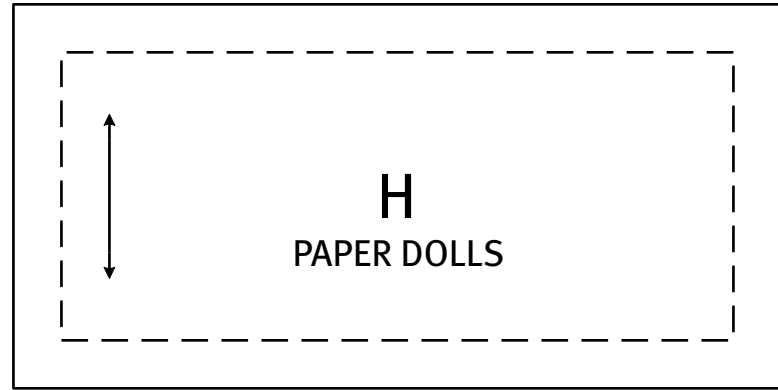
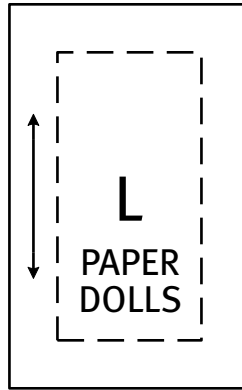
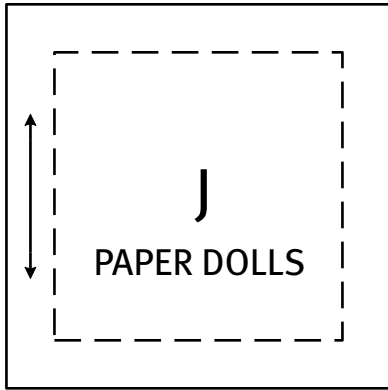
Making the quilt

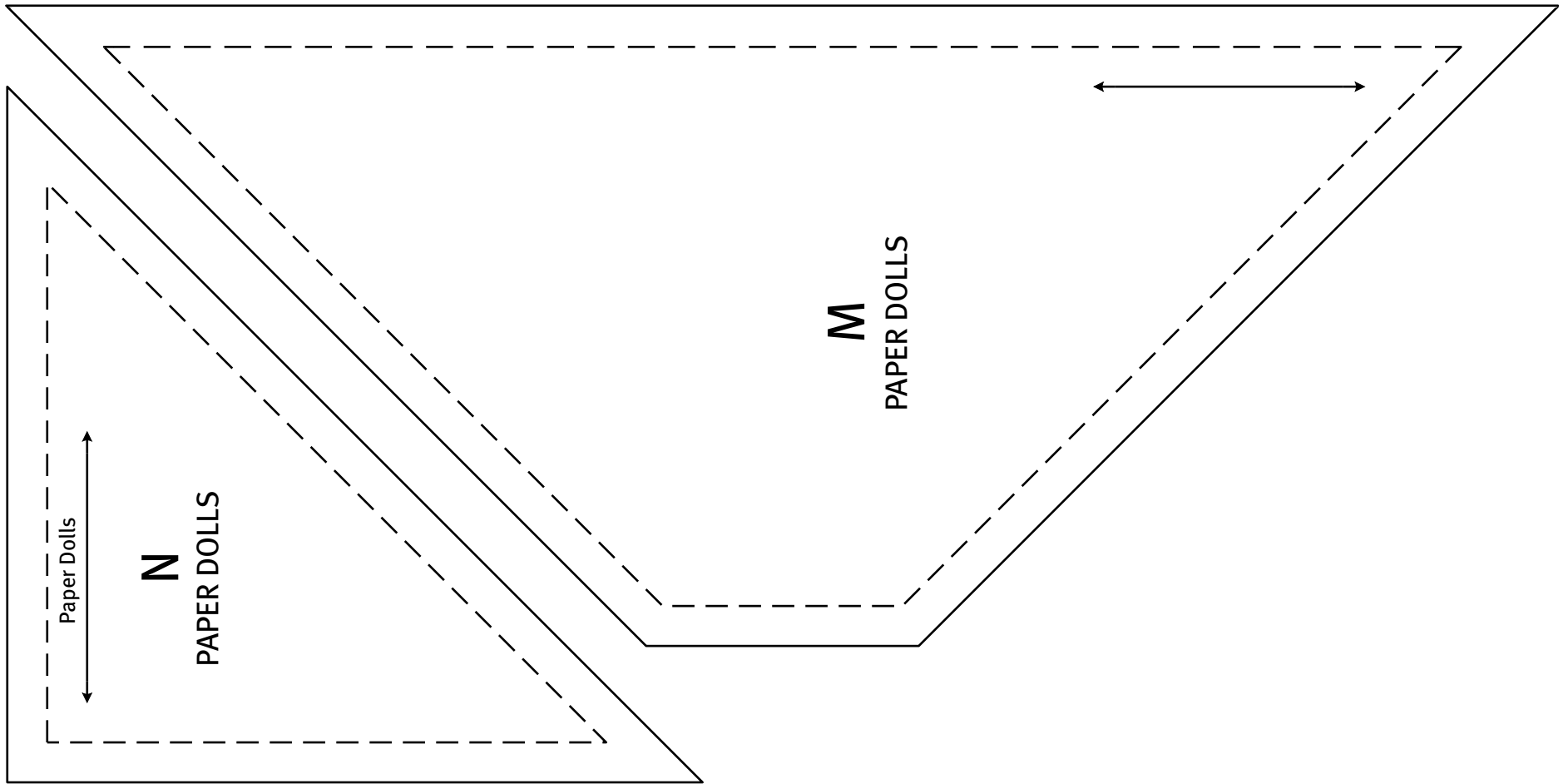
Join the blocks into 6 rows as shown in the quilt assembly diagram using the Large Rectangles to fill the ends of the 2nd, 4th and 6th row. Join the rows to make the quilt center. Join the side borders to the quilt center, then add a border corner post to each end of the top and bottom borders and then join them to the center to complete the quilt.

Finishing the quilt

Press the quilt top. Seam the backing pieces using a $\frac{1}{4}$ in (.64cm) seam allowance to form a piece approximately 58in x 67in (147.25 x 170.25cm). Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and baste together. Quilt in a meandering pattern across the surface to the quilt using toning machine quilting thread or alternatively quilt in the ditch to highlight the doll shapes. Trim the quilt edges and attach the binding.
