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# Swatches Quilt

#### **Additional Requirements:**

90" x 90" (228.6cm x 228.6cm) quilt batting Coats Cotton Thread Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat

### **Cutting Instructions**

#### Note

**WOF**=Width of Fabric, **LOF**=Length of fabric From each of Fabrics A-R:

(2) 4½" (11.43cm) x WOF; subcut into (8) 4½" x 4½" (11.43cm x 11.43cm)

(1) 2½" (6.35cm) x WOF (for second border)

(1) 2½" (6.35cm) x WOF (for binding)

#### Fabric S:

(8) 4½" (11.43cm) x WOF; subcut (160) 2" x 4½" (5.08cm x 11.43cm)

(8) 6" (15.24cm) x WOF; subcut (160) 2" x 6" (5.08cm x 15.24cm)

(8) 2" (5.08cm) x WOF (for first border)

(8) 3½" (8.89cm) x WOF (for third border)

(13) 2" x 2" (5.08cm x 5.08cm)

#### **Backing:**

(2) WOF x 90" (228.6cm)

#### **Sewing Instructions:**

Use a 1/4" (.64cm) seam allowance throughout.

- 1. Sew a 2" x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (5.08cm x 11.43cm) rectangle to the top of a 41/2" (11.43cm) square. Sew a 2" x 6" (5.08cm x 15.24cm) rectangle to the right side of the square. Diagram 1 Make a total of 144 blocks. Square up each block to measure 6" x 6" (15.24cm x 15.24cm). Press seam allowances toward the rectangles.
- 2. Arranging the blocks on a design wall or flat surface, set the blocks into 12 horizontal rows with 12 blocks in each row. Sew a 2" x 6" (5.08cm x 15.24cm) rectangle to the left side of the first block in each row. Sew the blocks together in rows. Sew the rows together matching all seams. Square up the quilt top to measure 66½" x 66½" (168.9cm x 168.9cm).
- 3. Beginning and ending with a 2" (5.08cm) square, sew together a bottom strip using the 2" (5.08cm) squares and remaining 2" x 41/2" (5.08cm x 11.43cm) rectangles. Square up the guilt top to measure 68" x 68" (172.72cm x 172.72cm).

#### Quilt Assembly

4. Sew the 2" (5.08cm) x WOF border strips short ends together in sets of two. Measure the guilt top vertically through the center. Trim two strips to this measurement and sew to the left and right sides of the guilt top. Press the seam allowance toward the border strips. Measure the guilt top horizontally through the center, including the side borders. Trim two strips to this measurement and sew to the top and bottom

- of the guilt top. Press seam allowances toward the Diagram 1 border strips. Square up the quilt top to measure 71" x 71" (180.34cm x 180.34cm).
  - 5. For the next border, choose 16 of the 2½" (6.35cm) print strips. Sew the strips short ends together in sets of four. Measure the guilt top vertically through the center. Trim two strips to this measurement and sew to the left and right sides of the guilt top. Press seam allowances toward the border strip. Next, measure the guilt top horizontally through the center. Trim two strips to this measurement and sew to the top and bottom of the guilt top. Press toward the border strip. Square up the quilt top to measure  $75" \times 75"$ (190.5cm x 190.5cm).
  - 6. Sew the 3½" (8.89cm) x WOF border strips short ends together in sets of two. Measure the guilt top vertically through the center. Trim two strips to this measurement and sew to the left and right sides of the guilt top. Press the seam allowances toward the print border strips. Measure the guilt top horizontally through the center. Trim two strips to this measurement and sew to the top and bottom of the guilt top. Press the seam allowances toward the print border strips. Square up the guilt top to measure 81" x 81" (205.74cm x 205.74.cm).
  - 7. Sew the two backing pieces together and square up to measure 89" x 89" (226.06cm x 226.06cm).
  - 8. Layer the guilt top right side up on top of the batting and the wrong side of the backing. Quilt as desired. Trim the backing and bathing even with the quilt top
  - 9. Sew 17 of the 2½" (6.35cm) x WOF strips set aside for binding into one long strip. Bind as desired.

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
